6.	内容简述: 澳大利亚已对全蛋、蛋黄和蛋白粉的进口条件进行了政策审查。报告建议增加新的热处理要求, 作为现有热处理要求的替代选择, 新增热处理要求低于现有热处理要求, 更接近标准行业惯例。新条件可确保贸易的连续性, 并管理生物安全风险, 以达到澳大利亚的适当保护水平。

6. **Description of content:** Australia has conducted a policy review of the Australian import conditions for whole egg, egg yolk, and egg white powder. The report recommends new heat treatment requirements which are lower than existing heat treatment requirements and are closer to standard industry practices be added as an alternative option to existing heat treatment requirements. The new conditions ensure continuity of trade and manage the biosecurity risks to meet Australia's appropriate level of protection.
